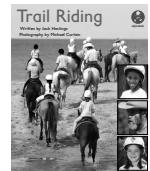
This book describes how a family operates a trail riding business and how they run trail rides each day.

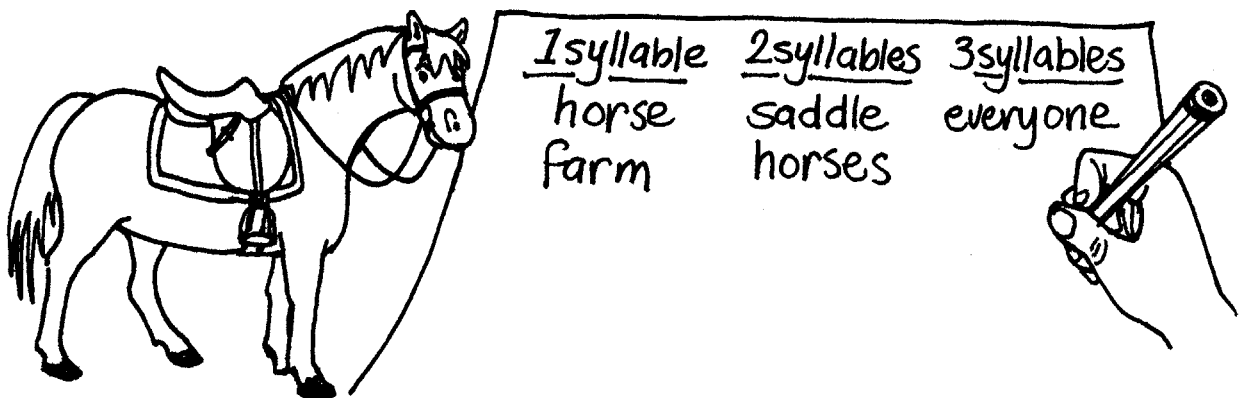

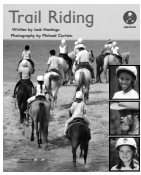
You will need:

4. Share your list with the class.





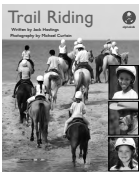
