His father could swim.


His grandma could swim.

“I want to learn to swim,” said Sebastian.

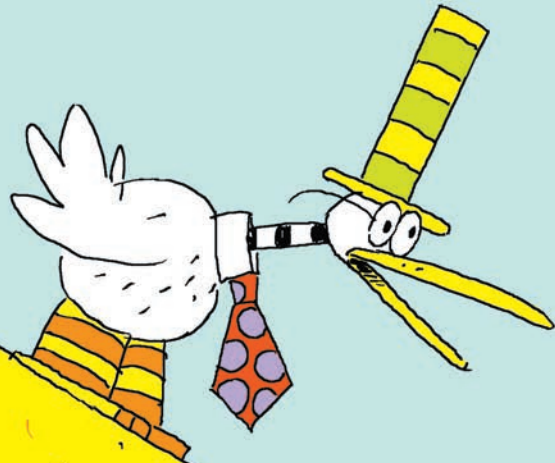




His mother said,

"See! I can't swim," said Sebastian.



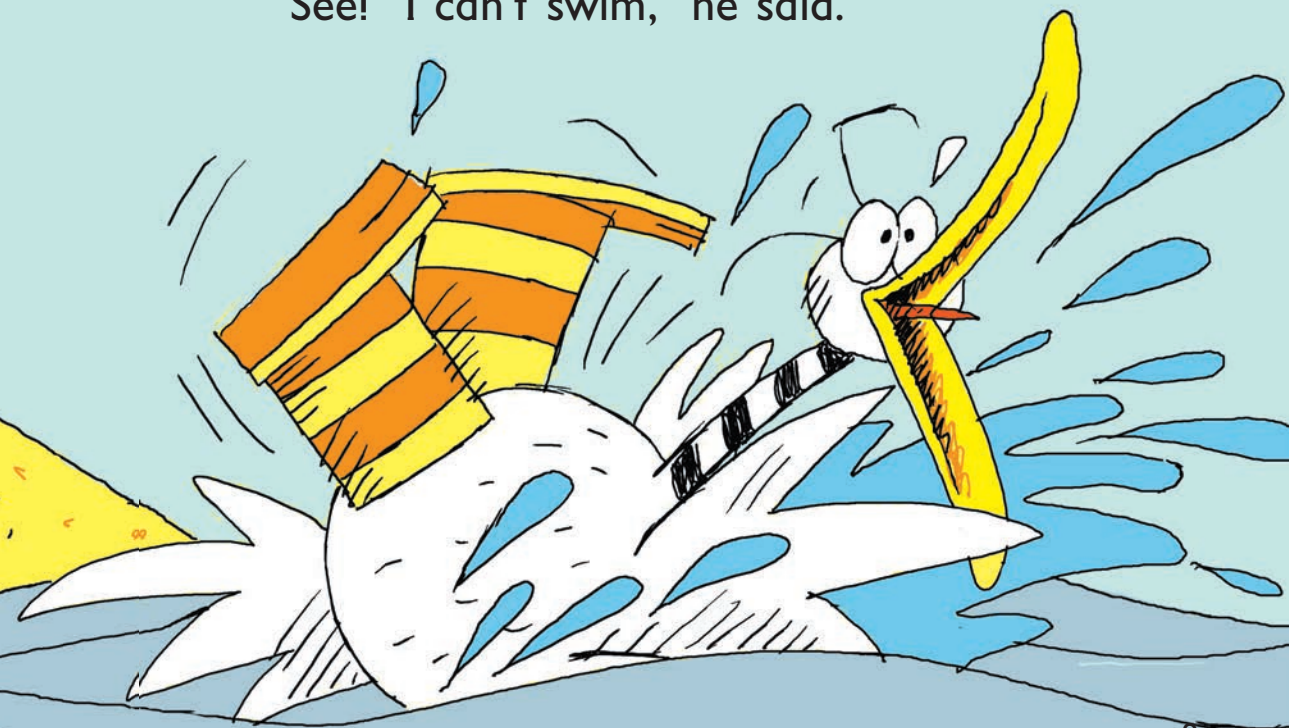
